

Carriage for Forklift

Carriage for Forklift - Rated by the tine carriage hoisting capability, there are four sizes of hook type blade carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is roughly 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted tines vary by the amount of offset between the tine and the fork eye. Some makers will differ the carriages for pin type tines. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
